ACTION TAKEN: Approved

ACTION TAKEN: Rakotz/Cheever/Approved (5-0)

Flaaen explained a request to remove the existing sign consisting of raceway channel lettering which is internally illuminated. The proposed sign is 156" long and approximately 30" tall, resulting in an approximately 32-sq. ft. sign. The sign has previously been located at Midtown Square. Bob Gruber of Scenic Sign Corp was present to answer questions regarding the proposed sign. The LED sign can be updated to use a warmer light. It is more yellow than the bright white or blue LEDs, but not a true yellow. A second sign was proposed for the east façade of the building. The second sign was designed as an aluminum frame flag mount sign with the same warm LED lighting.

Rakotz made a motion to approve the request as proposed including the second sign and using the warm LED lighting. The motion was seconded by Cheever. Rakotz stated she would be Fandel called for a vote, and the motion carried unanimously.
