Job Description

The Athletic Field Maintenance is responsible for the facility grounds and facilities in Whitney Memorial Park. Must have a driver's license as you will be operating lawn mowers and city vehicles.

Salary

- Starts at \$15.55/hour

Location

- Whitney Recreation Center/Whitney Memorial Park

Type of Position

- Hours based on program needs.
- Hours will include days, evenings, weekends, and holidays.
- Must adhere to work schedule and hours assigned.
- Hours may be limited by inclement weather.

Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Must have a valid Minnesota Driver's License.
- Must be able to complete task without direct supervision.
- Must have the knowledge of routine field maintenance procedures.
- Must be able to have flexible hour's day, night and weekends.
- Ability to perform tasks of a physical nature, including bending, kneeling, lifting; and to work outdoors in a variety of weather conditions (heat, humidity, rain, cold).
- Responsible work attitude, as well as reliable, organized work habits.
- Working ability to understand and follow directions.
- Working ability to communicate effectively with the public and enforce the park rules.

Typical Duties Performed

- Responsible for opening/closing facility.
- Mowing grass, weed trimming, raking leaves, picking up brush and branches.
- Turf management such as field mowing, aerating, fertilizing, top dressing, edging and weed spraying.
- Maintains athletic activity areas through general field maintenance including pre-game field preparations and post-game preparations. Infield dragging, base placement, chalking/painting of lines, home plate and mound repairs.
- Maintain park fences, dugouts, bleachers, drinking fountains, sidewalks, restrooms and general repairs.
- Assures that all parks and fields are kept neat and orderly by picking up garbage and replacing garbage bags in the receptacles.

- Performs daily maintenance of machines, including washing and greasing of mowers, trailers, trucks.
- Performs building maintenance work, painting and repair of permanent structures.

Physical Factors

- Ability to perform tasks of a physical nature, including bending, kneeling, lifting up to 50lbs.
- Ability to perform in a variety of weather conditions; heat, humidity, rain, cold and wind.
