

NOTICE REGARDING CAMPAIGN LAWN SIGNS

The City of St. Cloud has ordinances that would normally restrict the placement of lawn signs. However, in a state general election year (even years), these ordinances are overruled by Minnesota Statutes 211B.045 *from 46 days before the primary until 10 days after the general election*. During that period campaign signs may be posted in any size and number.

For 2016 this period begins June 24th and ends November 18th.

Note that while the size and number of signs are exempted from local ordinance, signs placed in the right of way or in locations where they may create a hazard for motorists will be removed by the City.

A basic rule of thumb for lawn sign placement is to place them inside of the City sidewalk. Signs placed on the boulevard are in the public right of way and will be removed without notice.
